The ENVISIO Digital Hub pilot trials are officially starting across all partner countries! This important stage marks the transition from development to real-world implementation, during which learners, trainers, and deaf youth ambassadors will explore and evaluate the platform's inclusive learning features.

This pilot phase will play a key role in refining the Hub before its official public release, ensuring it meets the diverse needs of learners and supports equal access to quality green entrepreneurship training across Europe.

LEARNING, TEACHING & TRAINING ACTIVITIES

During 2025, the ENVISIO consortium completed two Learning, Teaching and Training Activities (LTTs), both of which played a vital role in advancing the project's goals of inclusive education, digital innovation, and sustainable entrepreneurship. These activities strengthened cooperation among partners and provided hands-on experience in developing and testing the educational tools that will shape the ENVISIO Digital Hub.

>>> NICOSIA - CREATING AUGMENTED REALITY CASE **STUDIES**

The second Learning, Teaching and Training Activity of ENVISIO was hosted in Nicosia, Cyprus, gathering representatives from all partner organisations for an intensive, in-person training session focused on creating Augmented Reality (AR) case studies.

The session aimed to equip participants with the practical knowledge and technical understanding required to transform complex sustainability and entrepreneurship concepts into interactive AR learning experiences that can engage both deaf youth and vocational trainers.

Partners received step-by-step guidance from MECB (Malta) — the consortium's partner specialising in digital technologies and immersive learning tools. The training explored:

- Techniques for designing accessible AR content,
- Best practices for embedding AR into educational materials for deaf learners,
- Strategies for combining visual storytelling and interactivity to reinforce learning outcomes.

Participants worked collaboratively to develop early AR prototypes aligned with the five ENVISIO training programmes on green entrepreneurship and sustainability. The workshop fostered creativity, knowledge exchange, and strong teamwork, ensuring that the produced content aligns with universal design principles and accessibility standards.

The LTT in Nicosia represented a significant milestone, as it bridged technical capacity-building with pedagogical creativity — turning ENVISIO's educational vision into tangible, digital learning resources.

The third Learning, Teaching and Training Activity of ENVISIO, hosted in Uşak, Turkey, built on the outcomes of previous training sessions and introduced the project's most inclusive phase yet. This two-day event engaged deaf youth, sign-language interpreters, educators, and partner representatives in testing and adapting the ENVISIO Digital Hub and its training programmes for maximum accessibility, inclusiveness, and sustainability.

Participants explored the Hub's multilingual features, interactive components, and AR-based accessibility tools, offering constructive feedback on usability, design, and content clarity. Collaborative workshops encouraged brainstorming, co-design, and prototype testing, ensurin g that every educational component was intuitive and engaging for diverse learners.

The event also provided a platform for peer learning among interpreters, trainers, and young participants, who shared personal insights on improving digital inclusion and sustainable learning practices. Through open dialogue, participants discussed how the ENVISIO Hub can serve as a bridge between entrepreneurship and equal opportunities.

During this activity, Deaf youth participants from Italy and Latvia who were unable to travel joined the sessions live online, supported by sign-language interpreters!

The partners' decision to adopt a hybrid learning format opened new opportunities for more participants from ENVISIO's target groups to engage in this hands-on experience focused on green entrepreneurship and sustainable innovation.
