1. User Registration

1.1 Purpose

The user registration procedure serves several critical purposes within the ENVISIO Digital Hub. It is the gateway that connects each participant with a secure, personalised learning environment and ensures that the entire educational process remains structured, traceable and ethically managed.

First, registration establishes identity and authenticity. Each participant receives a unique user profile that links their activities, progress and assessment results to an individual record. This guarantees that certificates and achievements are issued only to genuine users who have completed the learning requirements.

Secondly, the process supports pedagogical monitoring and evaluation. The learning management system records engagement statistics such as Module completion rates, quiz performance and time spent on each activity. These data are vital for the consortium's ongoing evaluation of the platform's effectiveness and are used exclusively in aggregated, anonymised form.

Thirdly, registration ensures compliance with data protection and ethical standards. Before creating an account, users are informed about the type of information collected, the purpose of data use and their right to withdraw consent. This step aligns with GDPR and the project's ethical guidelines, reinforcing participants' control over their personal information.

Finally, the registration procedure fosters a sense of belonging and accountability. When learners sign up, they formally join a wider European learning community dedicated to sustainability and inclusion. Their profile becomes a digital record of achievement that can be retained as evidence of participation in an Erasmus+ certified programme, thus encouraging long-term engagement with green entrepreneurship and lifelong learning opportunities.

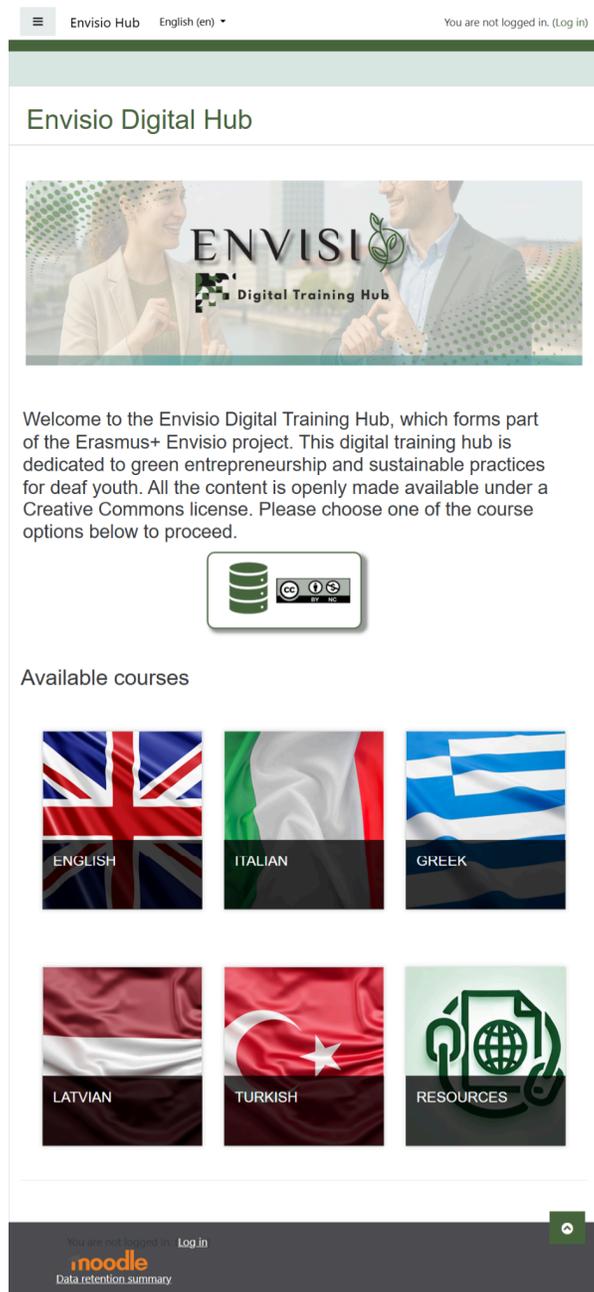
2.2 Process

The user registration process has been designed to be intuitive, secure and accessible to all participants, including deaf and hard-of-hearing users. It ensures that every learner can join the ENVISIO Digital Hub without difficulty, regardless of their digital proficiency or device type. The process consists of five main stages.



Step 1 – Accessing the Registration Page

Participants enter the [Digital Hub](#) through the official project link provided by their national partner organisation or through the [ENVISIO website](#). On the landing page, they select their preferred language by clicking the appropriate flag icon, which redirects them to the course interface in English, Italian, Greek, Latvian or Turkish.

The form requires basic information necessary for both pedagogical and administrative purposes. The standard fields include:

- Choosing a unique username which will be used for login credentials

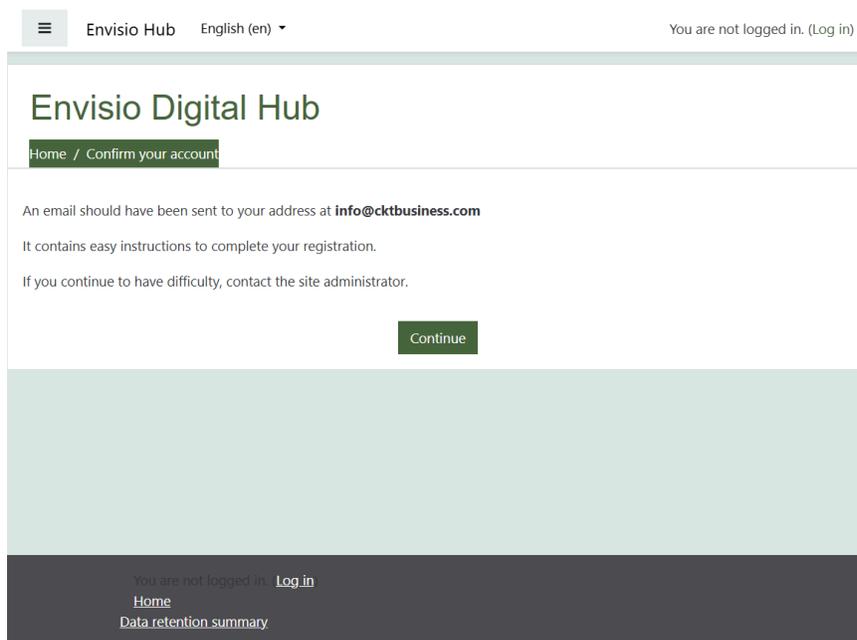


- Choosing a strong password. The password must have at least 8 characters, at least 1 digit(s), at least 1 lower case letter(s), at least 1 upper case letter(s), at least 1 non-alphanumeric character(s) such as *, -, or #
- Email address: for the verification of login credentials and communication.
- Email (again): for email validation
- First name and Surname: for identification and certification.
- City/town and Country of residence: to group participants for national reporting. This information is optional.

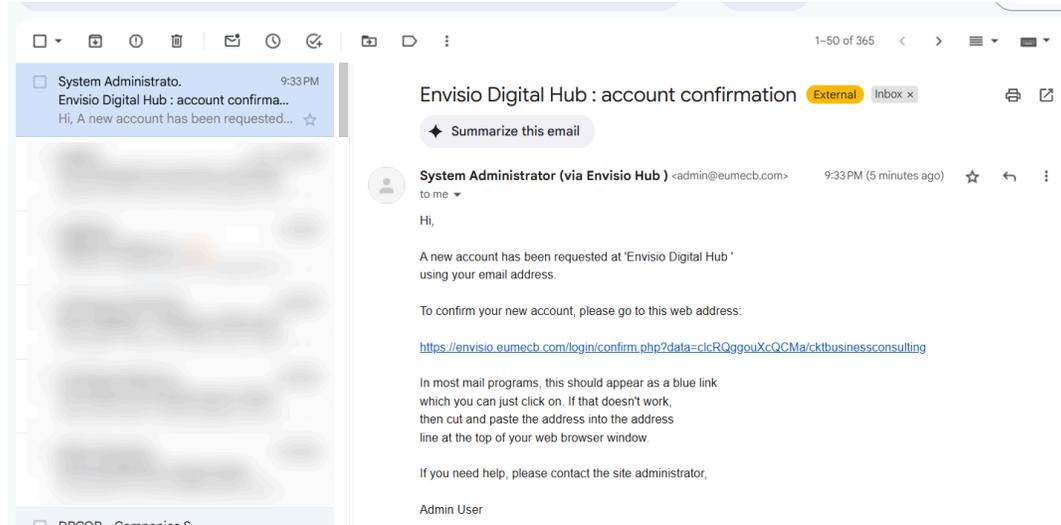
The exclamation mark next to the fields of the form indicates required information. The registration cannot be completed without this information.

Step 3 - Email Verification

Once step 2 is successfully completed, the below message will appear on the screen.

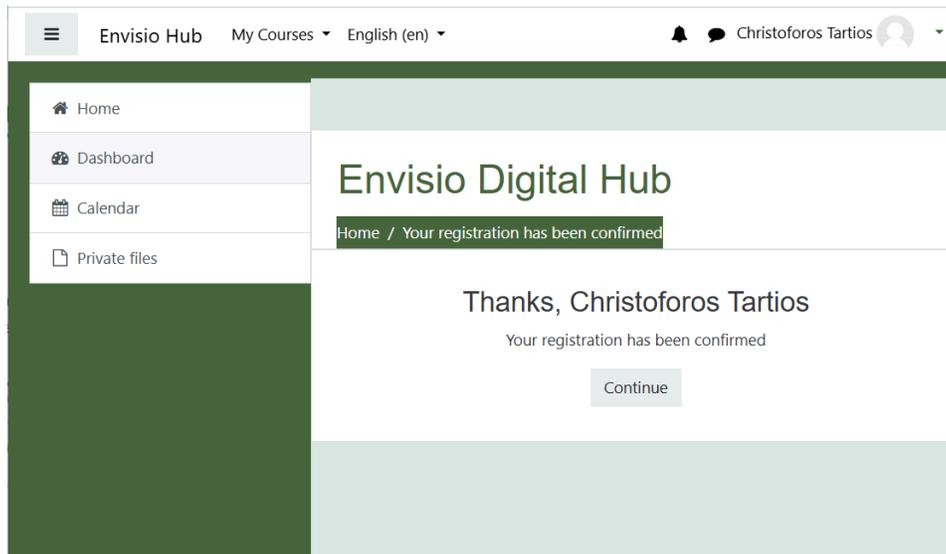


Users must enter their email account as per the above instructions to confirm their account. They will receive an email and this shall look like the photo below. Users must also check their spam folder in case the email is not available in their inbox folder.



To confirm the account, users must click on the link provided on the email.

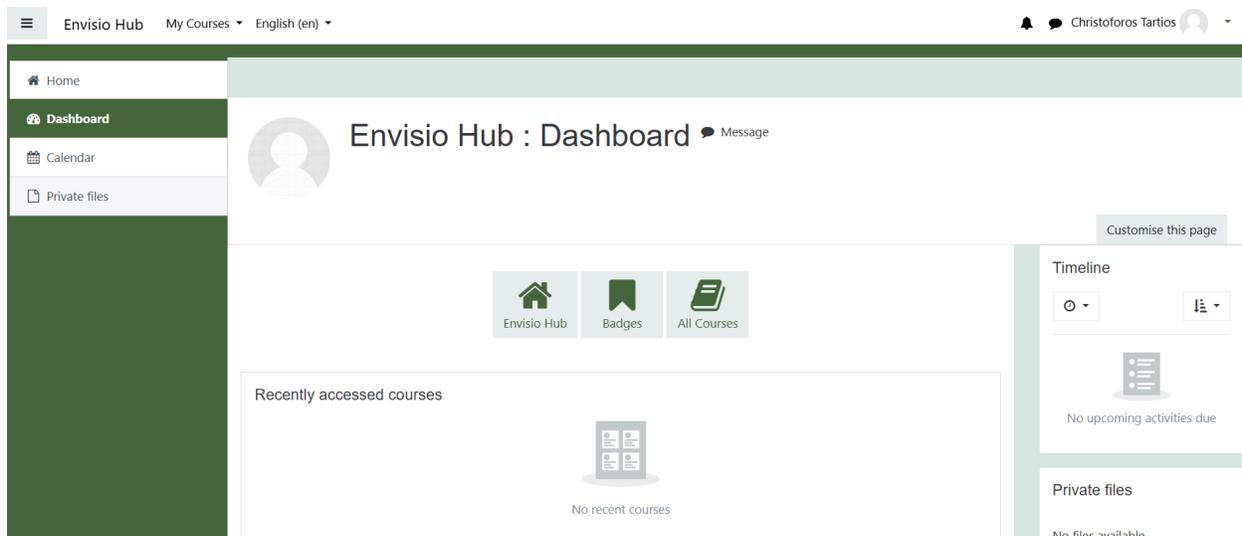

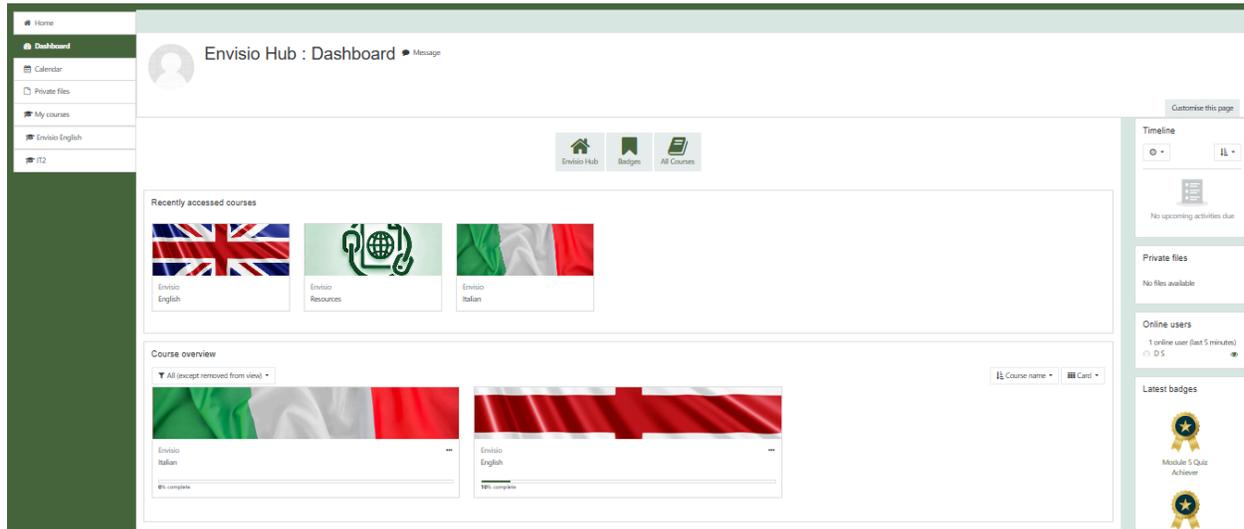

Dashboard

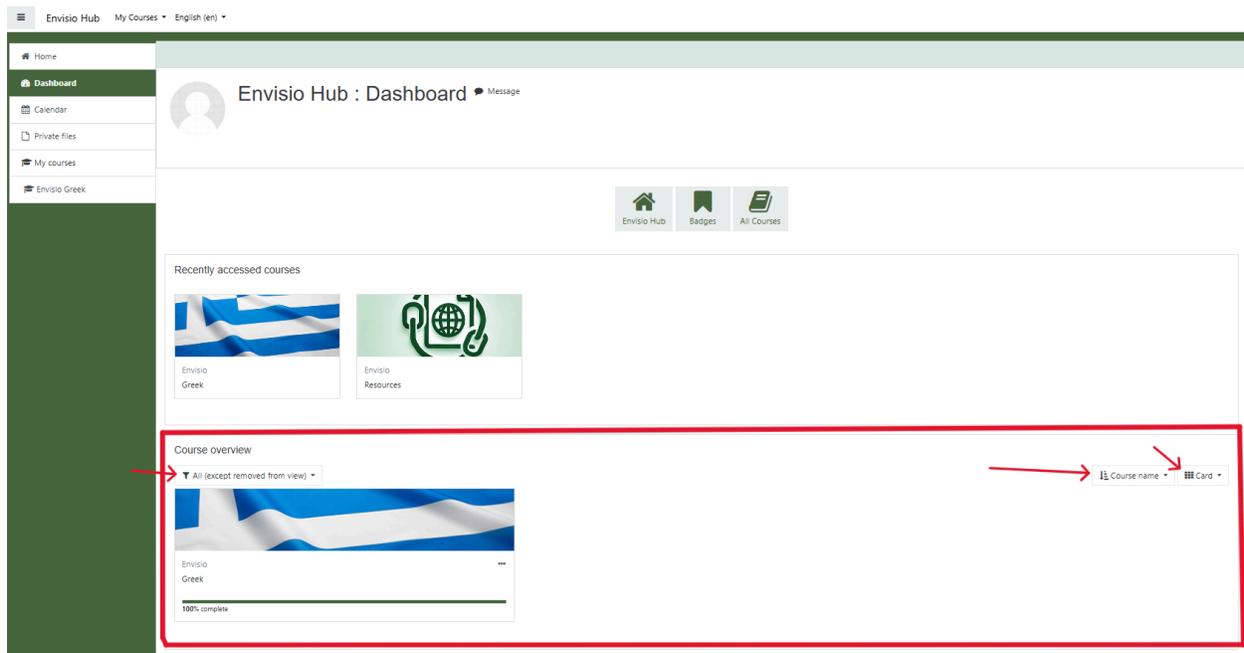


Dashboard is your personalized, customizable start page in ENVISIO Digital Hub, acting as a central place for accessing your learning activities. It provides an overview of your progress, upcoming deadlines, and the courses you're enrolled in.

Recently Accessed Courses/Items: This block gives you quick access to the courses or activities you last visited, making it easy to return to your recent work.



Course Overview: This is the main area where you see all the courses you are enrolled in.

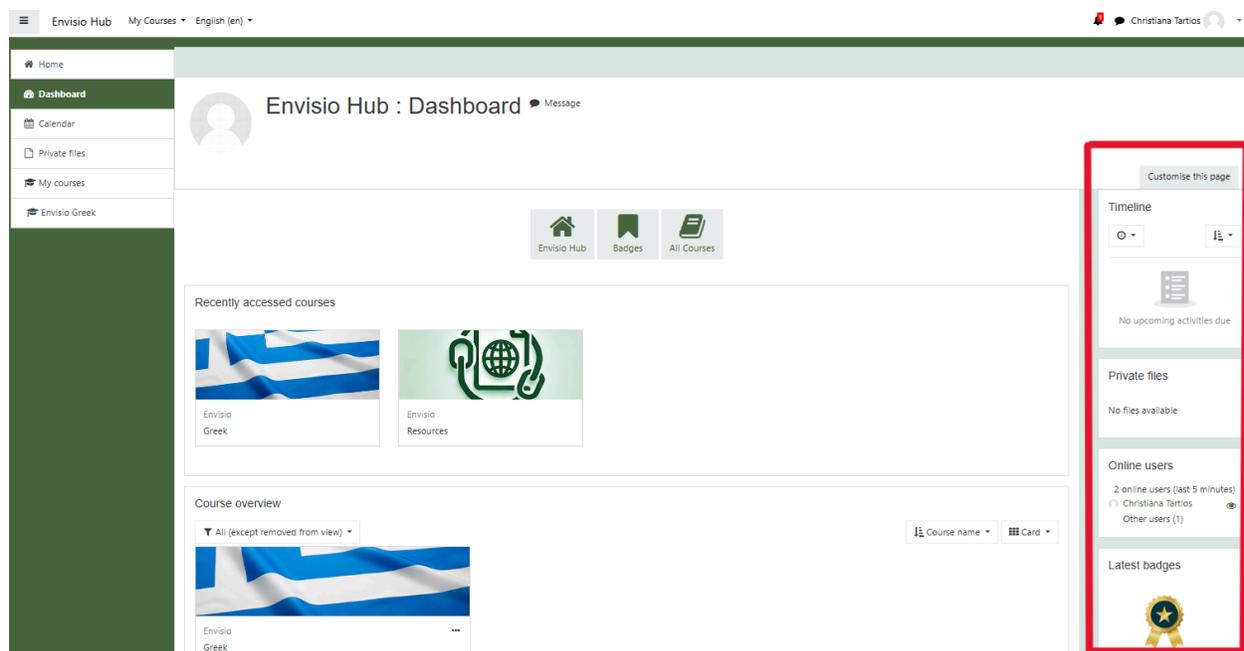


What you can find here:

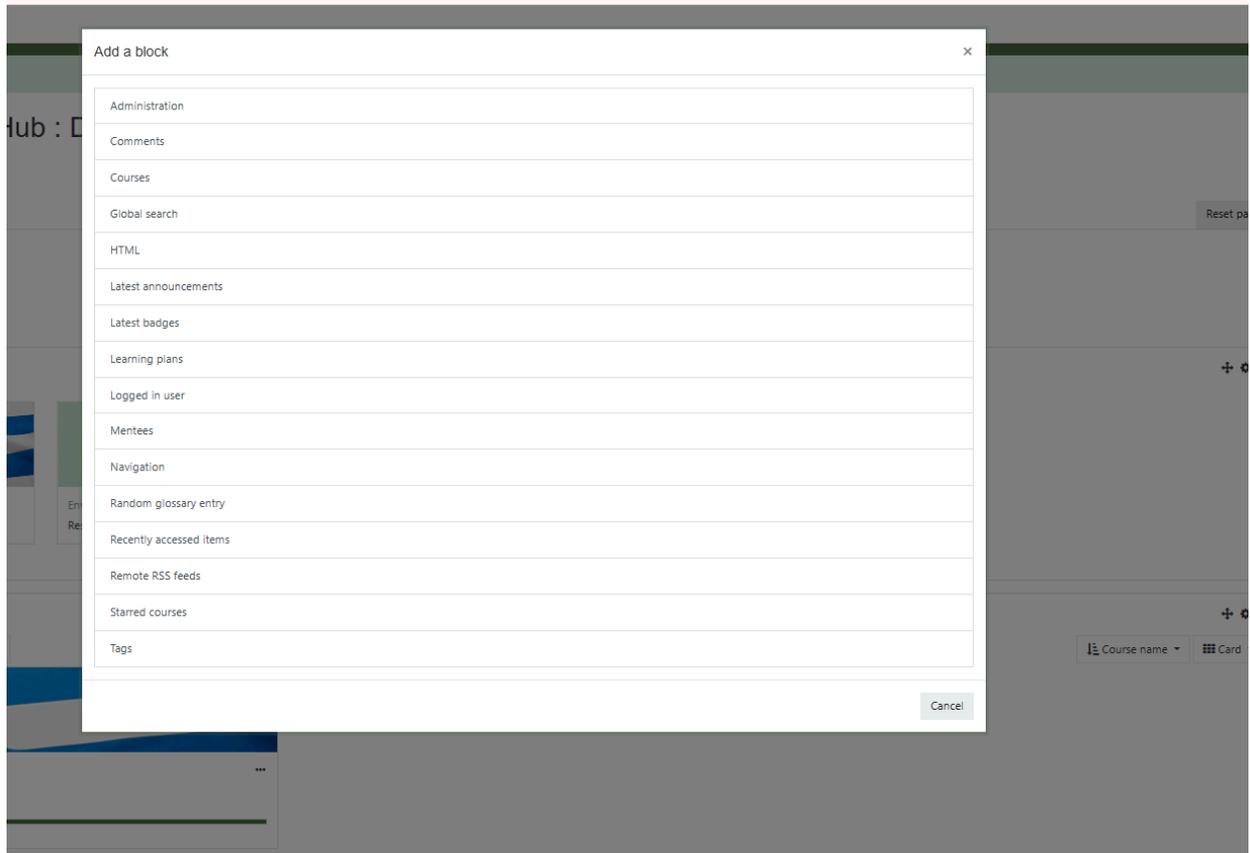


- Filtering: You can filter the courses to show only those that are In progress, Past, Future, or Starred (favorites).
- Sorting: Courses can be sorted by course name or last accessed date.
- Display: You can typically choose to view courses as Cards (with images), a List, or a Summary.
- Starring/Removing: Users can "star" courses to mark them as favorites for easy filtering or "remove from view" to hide less frequently used courses.

A major advantage of the Dashboard is its customizability, allowing you to tailor the page to your needs:



1. **Editing Mode:** By clicking a button like "**Customise this page**" or "**Turn editing on,**" you enter an editing mode.
2. **Adding Blocks:** You can add various information blocks to your dashboard, such as **Timeline, Private files, Online Users, Latest Badges, Calendar, or Upcoming Events.**



- 3. **Moving Blocks:** You can drag and drop blocks to reorder them or move them between different sections of the page.
- 4. **Hiding/Deleting Blocks:** You have the option to hide or completely remove blocks that aren't useful to you.

These personal changes only affect *your* view of the dashboard. Most common blacks are:

Block Name	Typical Look	Purpose
Course Overview	Course cards or a list with a picture, title, and progress bar for each course.	Displays all the courses you are enrolled in. It allows for filtering (In progress, Past, Future, Starred), sorting, and changing the display style (Card, List, Summary).
Timeline	A list of upcoming activities (assignments, quizzes, etc.) with their due dates.	Helps you track upcoming due dates and links directly to the activity. Can be sorted by date or course.



Calendar	A mini-calendar month view. Dates with events (like assignment due dates) are highlighted.	Helps you track upcoming due dates and links directly to the activity. Can be sorted by date or course.
Recently Accessed Courses	A short list of the last 3-5 courses you viewed, often with small navigation arrows.	Provides instant links back to the courses you were just working on.
Latest Announcements	A list of recent posts from the main course Announcements forum.	Provides quick visibility into important, site-wide, or course-wide messages from the teacher or administrator.
Activities	A list of all the different <i>types</i> of activities (e.g., Assignments, Forums, Quizzes, Resources) in the current course.	Gives a shortcut link to a page listing <i>all</i> items of a particular type (e.g., click "Assignments" to see all assignments in the course).
Navigation	A hierarchical tree-view menu with links to your Dashboard, Site Home, My Courses, and the current course's sections/activities.	Provides a structured way to jump to any major area of Moodle or within your current course.
Text (or HTML)	Fully customizable text, images, videos, or even custom HTML code.	Used to add welcome messages, quick links, course contact information, or embedded media like YouTube videos. You can add multiple instances of this block.
Online Users	A list of users who are currently logged in and active in the last five minutes (or a different configured time).	Shows who is active in the current course or on the site.
People/Participants	A link that takes you to the full list of users enrolled in the current course.	Allows quick access to the class list to view profiles or send messages.

Profile



Accessing your profile in ENVISIO Digital Hub is a straightforward process, regardless of which page you are currently viewing. The most common way to access your profile is through the User Menu in the top-right corner of the screen.

Here are the step-by-step instructions:

1. **Locate the User Menu:** Look at the **top right corner** of your Moodle screen. You will see your **name** and usually your **profile picture** (or a generic icon if you haven't uploaded one).
2. **Click to Open the Menu:** Click on your **name** or the **profile picture/icon**. This will open a dropdown menu.
3. **Select "Profile":** In the dropdown menu, click on the **"Profile"** link.



This will take you to your main profile page, where you can:

- View your user details, course details and login activity.



- Find a link to **"Edit profile"** to change your picture, description, interests, and other details as shown in the picture below.

- **Blog Entries**

This section relates to a built-in **Blogging** feature.

- **Function:** It is a link that displays a list of all the blog posts (entries) that you have personally created on the site.
- **User Control:** You can usually see your own entries, and depending on your permission settings and how you've chosen to publish them, other users on the site may be able to view them as well.

- **My Certificates**

This is a feature related to the official completion of courses on the site.

- **Function:** It provides a central location for you to view, download, and manage the official digital certificates you have earned for completing ENVISIO courses.

- **Forum Posts**

This section is a detailed record of your participation in all ENVISIO **Forums**.

- **Function:** It displays a list of **every individual reply or new discussion topic** you have contributed to in all forums across all the courses you are enrolled in.
- **Purpose:** It allows you to quickly find and review all of your specific contributions to discussions on the site.



● Forum Discussions

This section works alongside "Forum Posts" to give a holistic view of your forum activity.

- **Function:** This link typically displays a list of all the **original discussion topics** you have started (i.e., the first post in a new conversation thread) within various ENVISIO forums.
- **Relationship to Posts:** "Forum Discussions" shows the threads you initiated, while "Forum Posts" shows every single reply you've ever made, including those in discussions started by others.

Learning Plans is a structured approach to learning and tracking progress. Not specific setting for ENVISIO users.
